MST Prep (\$105)

We'll help you prepare for the ICBC Motorcycle Skills Test, and you'll be able to practice riding the actual test layout.

MST Motorcycle Rental (\$65, \$60 when purchased with MST Prep)

If you're ready to take the Motorcycle Skills Test at ICBC but don't have a bike, or if your bike is too big or its pipes are too loud for use at ICBC, we will deliver one of our bikes to ICBC for you.

Road Test Prep (\$125)

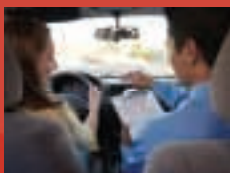
